1. The learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that in Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.2591 of 2023 the possession of the secured asset has been received. He submits that insofar as Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.2632 of 2023 is concerned, the borrower has approached the Debts Recovery Tribunal and interim protection has been granted.
