1. The grievance of the Petitioner is that the Zilla Parishad, Sindhudurg is not issuing an appointment order only because the name of the Petitioner appears in the Teacher Eligibility Test (T.E.T.) results scam. Criminal investigation is on going.

2. The case before us is such that the prospective Employer desires to check the antecedents of a candidate, who is likely to be engaged as an Employee. Therefore, the issue would be whether the prospective Employer can be issued with a *Writ of*

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Mandamus to engage a candidate, whose antecedents are tainted.

3. **Issue notice** to the Respondents, returnable on **28th January, 2025**. The learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent No.1.

4. Let the affidavit in reply be filed, at least ten days, prior to the returnable date.
