The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Caste Certificate dated 6<sup>th</sup> August 1997 bearing No.216/1997 was issued by the Sub-Divisional Officer certifying that the petitioner belongs to “Dhangar – Nomadic Tribe”. The Scrutiny Committee on 14<sup>th</sup> October 1999 issued a Validity Certificate to the petitioner. However, the number of the Caste Certificate stated therein is different from the Caste Certificate issued to the petitioner. For this reason, the petitioner has not been found eligible for seeking admission at the Post-Graduate Homoeopathy Course.

2. Leave granted to the petitioner to implead the Secretary, Caste Certificate Scrutiny Committee, Pune as respondent no.7. The amendment be carried out forthwith.

3. Thereafter issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 28<sup>th</sup>

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November 2024. The learned Assistant Government Pleader waives notice for respondent nos.4 to 7. Other respondents be duly served.

4. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is permitted to continue his education subject to outcome of the writ petition.
