(ii) Whether the office of the plaintiff situated at Kolhapur would confer any jurisdiction on the Civil Court at Kolhapur on

the ground that some of the payments were made at Kolhapur in as much as it is admitted by plaintiff that even the plaintiff's bank account is at Chiplun ?

(iii) Whether the findings recorded by both the courts on territorial jurisdiction at Kolhapur would amount to incorrect appreciation of the pleadings and evidence on record ?
