1 The interim application is to bring on record the legal heirs of respondent no.3, i.e., proposed respondent nos.3(a), 3(b) and 3(c).

2 There is a bailiff's affidavit on record which indicates that proposed respondent no.3(a) has been served but proposed respondent nos.3(b) and 3(c) have not been served. It is recorded that proposed respondent no.3(a), who is the mother of proposed respondent nos.3(b)

and 3(c), refused to accept service on behalf of proposed respondent nos.3(b) and 3(c) on the ground that those two were her married daughters and living with their respective in-laws.
