1. Heard learned Advocate for the Claimant and learned Advocate for Appellant-MSRTC.
2. It is true that this Court on 8th May 2024 permitted the Claimants to withdraw 30% of the deposited amount along with

interest. This Application is for withdrawal of further amount to the extent of 20%. It is opposed. However, considering the fact that there was a death claim, 50% must be allowed to be withdrawn. Hence, order:-
