(b) Petitioner-mother is at liberty and is entitled to have daily access/visitation right with minor child Ms. 'S', either by way of Video Conferencing for one to two hours or personal visitation at the address of the Respondent No.2 mentioned in the cause title of the Petition.

3) We expect that, the parties herein will resolve their disputes and differences amicably by taking into consideration the paramount interest of the minor child Ms. 'S'.

4) At the joint request of learned Advocates for the parties, stand over to 17th May 2024.
