- 3) Mr. Pradhan, learned senior Advocate appearing for the Petitioners raises a contention that, the Bitcoin which is alleged to be a valuable commodity under Section 2(c) of the Maharashtra Protection of Interest of Depositors (In Financial Establishments) Act, 1999 ('MPID Act'), is not legally acceptable tender in India and therefore, Sections 3 and 4 of the MPID Act cannot be applied to the present crime.

5) Till the returnable date, further proceedings in Sessions Case No.70 of 2013 pending on the file of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ichalkaranji *qua* the Petitioners are stayed.
