1. The present application was circulated today. The present application impugns an order passed by the Court of Sessions at Pune dated 11th July, 2024. The Petitioners had approached the Sessions Court Pune against the order dated 7th December, 2023 passed by the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Khadki, Pune in Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.27 of 2020. By the Impugned Order, the Appeal filed by the Petitioners was partly allowed and the interim maintenance which was granted by the Trial Court was reduced from Rs.90,000/- to Rs.50,000/-.

2. Learned Counsel for the Applicant has pointed out that apart from the issue of jurisdiction, the Impugned Order is also bad since it fails to take into

consideration the fact that the Affidavits of the Respondent (wife) though having disclosed monthly expenses in the sum of 3150 Singapore Dollar which is equivalent to Rs.1,81,025.79/- did not set out any details of the said expenses. Learned Counsel has also from the said Affidavit pointed out that the Respondent (wife) has disclosed her monthly income as 3400 Singapore Dollar which is equal to Rs.1,95,465.20/- i.e. her income being more than her expenditure. Learned Counsel submitted that it is thus that the Impugned Order has been challenged by way of the present Criminal Revision Application.

3. Having heard, issue notice to the Respondent returnable on 21st January, 2025. In addition to Court notice, private service is also allowed.
