1. The applicant is in jail from 5 years and 6 months and till date out of about 16 witnesses 4 have been examined.

2. Thus, considering the fact that the trial will be concluded in near future, I am of the opinion that the purpose would be served if the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within the stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, the application is disposed of with direction to the learned trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same in next six months.
