1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the State.

1. Mr. Thatte, the learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the Sessions Court has heard the application for pre-arrest bail on 8th May, 2024 and posted the same for passing order on 13th May, 2024.

2. In the meanwhile, on 23rd April, 2024 the Sessions Court had declined to grant ad-interim protection to the applicant. Therefore, the applicant was required to prefer this application.
