1. This is the second time that the Petitioner has approached this Court for anticipatory bail. On the first occasion, he had filed Anticipatory Bail Application No.181 of 2024, which was argued for some time and then it was withdrawn, which is reflected in the order dated 22/01/2024.

2. Learned counsel for the Applicant submitted that there is change in circumstances as the main accused is granted regular bail. However, that cannot be a change in circumstance

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because this particular application is for anticipatory bail and not for regular bail. On the first occasion, it was withdrawn way back in January 2024.

3. When I expressed disinclination to grant relief in this application, the learned counsel for the Applicant again prayed for unconditional withdrawal of this application as well.
4. Permission is granted. The application is allowed to be withdrawn unconditionally and is disposed of as such.
