. By this application, the applicant is seeking relaxation of condition No.(v) imposed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court (Coram: G. A. Sanap, J.) by order dated 6 November 2023 at the time of granting application for bail. The relevant operative part of the order reads thus-

“(v) Applicants shall not enter the area of Pune District till completion of trial, except for the purpose of attending the trial on the given date and that too with prior intimation to Bundgarden Police Station.”

2. The learned counsel for the applicant draws attention of this Court to the medical certificate annexed with this application to submit that the applicant's father was admitted as an emergency patient and is suffering from post viral reactive arthritis and myositis, Inflammatory myositis, Encephalopathy.
3. The learned APP, on instructions from the Officer of the concerned police station present in Court, states that the condition may be relaxed for a limited period in view of the fact that the father of the applicant is undergoing treatment and requires medical attention.
4. Having considered the submissions and the no objection from the prosecution, the applicant is permitted to enter Pune City in order to visit his ailing father, for a period of six weeks from today with a stipulation that the applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence or influence the witnesses, and shall scrupulously follow rest of the conditions imposed in the order.
5. All the parties shall act on the authenticated copy of this order.
6. Interim application stands disposed of accordingly.
