1. This application is for restoration of Criminal Application No.520 of 2023, which was dismissed vide the order dated 01/07/2024.

2. The learned counsel for Applicants invited my attention to the order dated 30/11/2023. Vide that order leave to amend was granted and the amendment was to be carried out within a period of one week from that date. Amendment was allowed to

enable the learned counsel for the Applicants to annex copy of the charge-sheet. Subsequently, vide the order dated 01/07/2024, the time to carry out amendment was extended upto 08/07/2024 as a last chance.
