- 2.** The Applicant has preferred this Application to withdraw an amount of Rs.1,85,000/- deposited in the Registry of this Court, pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 27th February 2024, with the interest accrued thereon
- 3.** The order of interim Anticipatory Bail was made absolute by an Order dated 21st October 2024.
