. On 5th March 2024, this Court passed the following order :

“ On 17th January 2024, this Court found that while the learned counsel for the caveator/defendant was present in Court and ready for arguments, there was no appearance on behalf of the petitioner/plaintiff. These proceedings were adjourned to 7th February 2024.

2. On 7th February 2024, due to paucity of time, the proceedings could not be taken up and they were adjourned to today.

4. The learned counsel for the defendant is pressing for dismissal of the suit.
