

4. The legal heirship certificate is required in the context of shares in the name of the deceased.
5. In view of the material placed on record, the petition is accepted and proclamation is dispensed with.
6. The petition is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a), which reads as follows:

“a) That a Legal Heirship Certificate be issued under the provision of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827, certifying that (1) Leelaben Roopchand Jain (widow and Petitioner herein) and (2) Rajiv Roopchand Jain (son of the deceased) are the only legal heirs and legal representatives of Deceased abovenamed.”
