) submits that deceased left behind him last

) executed at Mumbai on 31.12.2010. The  
) said Will is in English language.

) submits that deceased was governed under  
) the Hindu Succession Act, 1956. It is  
) submitted that the parents of the Deceased  
) pre-deceased the Deceased. The Deceased  
) has only two sons as mentioned above and  
) has no other son and daughter. The

) except as mentioned in para -8, there are no
