1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. On 07th May 2024, we have issued notices to the respondents, returnable on 18th June 2024.
3. Mr. Reis learned counsel for the petitioner/applicant states that the private service has been effected upon respondents No. 2 and 4 to 10. He states that even the bailiff has succeeded in serving

four of the respondents and reported that the remaining respondents have refused to accept the service.

4. For the present, we have not seen bailiff's report. Be that as it may, issue fresh notices to the respondents except BMC, returnable on 16th July 2024.
