) submits that deceased was governed under the  
) Hindu Succession Act, 1956. **It is submitted**  
) **that the parents of both the deceased**  
) **predeceased the deceased.** No son born from said

) kin left by the deceased.

) on record. Affidavit of Dakshata Suryakant Chalke,  
) one of the attesting witness to the Will is filed.  
) Affidavit of service of General Citation is filed. All  
) Affidavits are filed online. All other legal  
) formalities are complied with. Hence, Petition is  
) granted.
