PC.: 1. Perused the Petition. This petition is for Succession Certificate in respect of certain **Debts** belonging to the Deceased viz. Swapan Probodh Chaudhuri alias Swapankumar Chaudhuri, who died at Mumbai on 04.07.2014. Copy of death certificate is annexed at Exhibit- 'A' to the petition. Copy of Identification proof of deceased is already annexed at Exhibit- 'A-1' to the petition.

2. Upon perusal of petition, it is noticed that the said deceased was permanently residing at the time of his death at A504, Shankar enclave, Swayambhu Ganesh Marg, Ashok Nagar, Kandivali East, Mumbai – 400101 and left property in the State of West Bengal.

3. Upon perusal of petition, it is noticed that the legal heirs left behind the deceased surviving as her only heirs next-of-kin according to Hindu Succession Act, 1956 are mentioned in para no. 4 of the said petition.

4. Upon perusal of petition, it is noticed that the said deceased died intestate and that due and diligent search has been made for Will but none has been found.

6. In the aforesaid circumstances, I pass the following order:

- a. Office to Issue General Notice within two weeks from the date of uploading of this order.
- b. Advocate for the petitioner to file Affidavit of Service of General Notice and also effect service upon non-consenting legal heirs, if any as per Rules 399 and 400 of the Bombay High Court Original Side Rules and also justify surety of non-consenting legal heirs and furnish Administration Bond within one week thereafter.
- c. Office to verify if any cross petition is filed, if cross petition is filed, then take steps to place before the Hon'ble Court under Rule 407 of High Court Original Side Rules.
- d. List the matter on 03.07.2024 for compliance.
