1. Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner.
2. This petition is filed for grant of heirship certificate under Section 2 of the Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827.
3. Subhash Ganesh Karandikar (the deceased) was the husband of the Petitioner. The deceased passed away on 25th April, 2024. At the time of his death, he had a fixed place of abode at Flat No.4, Vasant Apartment, Shimpoli Road, Near Suvarna Hospital, Kastur Park, Boarivali West, Mumbai 400 092.
4. The petitioner avers that the deceased died intestate, and despite diligent search, no testamentary writing or Will has been found. The deceased left behind the petitioner and Shami Subhash Karandikar, the daughter, particulars of whom are furnished at Serial No. B in the table at paragraph 5 of the petition.

5. The heirship certificate is required to lay claim over the properties described in Schedule (Exhibit E). The petitioner and her daughter Shami appear to be surviving Class I legal heirs of the deceased. There is no other legal heir. Shami, the daughter has filed an affidavit giving her consent for grant of heirship certificate. I do not find any impediment in granting heirship certificate.

Hence, the following order :

ORDER

- (i) The Petition stands allowed in terms of prayer clause (a).
- (ii) Issue of proclamation is dispensed with.
- (iii) Grant expedited.
