2. Perused Schedule. The Petitioner is seeking permission to publish the Citation in two newspapers viz. “Free Press Journal” in English Language and in “Nava Bharat” in vernacular language i.e. Hindi.

3. Perused the Affidavit dated 17th January, 2024 annexed to Chamber Order. In Para-4 of the said Affidavit, it is stated that an attempt to serve the Citation through the Bailiff was made at the last

known address but the same has been returned back with Postal remark “Address insufficient”. In Para-8 of the Affidavit, the Petitioner had stated that he is not aware of any other / alternate address, hence it is essential to take steps to publish a Citation in newspapers as the whereabouts of the heirs of the deceased are not known to the Petitioner.

4. Perused Para-8 of the Petition, it is mentioned and confirmed that the averment made in the Affidavit in respect of the last known address known to the Petitioner.
