1. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.
2. This Interim Application is preferred to bring the legal representatives of Sardar Prabhjot Singh Bhagat Chandhok, the heirs of the deceased mentioned at serial No.1 in the table at paragraph No. 9 of the Petition for grant of Probate of the Last Will and Testament of Sardar Bhagat Singh Shobha Singh Chandhok (the deceased).
3. The learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that a copy of the application has been served on the proposed legal

representatives.

4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant seeks leave to tender affidavit of service.

5. Affidavit of service is taken on record.

6. The learned Counsel for the Applicant submitted that Sardar Prabhjot Singh Chandhok had filed an affidavit giving consent for grant of Probate. The said affidavit finds place at page No.35 of the Petition. Sardar Prabhjot Singh Chandhok had passed away on 1st December 2023.
