3. In the aforesaid background, we deem it appropriate to direct the petitioner to bring all these facts to the notice of the Collector, Gadchiroli, who shall look in to the grievance of the petitioner expeditiously.

4. With these directions, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.

5. Needless to state that in case if order adverse to the interest of the petitioner is passed, the petitioner is at liberty to take such steps as are permissible in law.
