2. Applicant/respondent no.1 has filed this application to direct the appellant to deposit the remaining awarded amount, along with interest, in this court. In response, learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that the appellant has deposited the entire compensation amount along with the interest in the court and accordingly has filed Pursis dated 25.04.2024 and therefore, submitted that the application became infructuous.

3. Having considered the said submission, Pursis and the fact that on 03.05.2024, the amount of Rs. 3,66,241/- has been credited in the bank account of the Court, it seems that the application becomes infructuous. In view of the same, the application is dismissed as infructuous.
