2. By this application, the applicant/appellant is seeking condonation of delay of 19 days in filing appeal. It is contended by the learned counsel for the appellant that she has approached to this Court for challenging the judgment and order dated 18.10.2023 passed by the 6th Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Akola.
