This is an application for grant of bail.

2. After hearing the learned counsel for applicant to some extent and after going through the investigation papers, I have shown my disinclination to grant bail.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant seeks liberty to file after six months if there is no substantial progress in the trial. The trial Court shall expedite the trial considering the small girl is involved mainly sexual assault.

4. Liberty is granted to the applicant to move after nine months if there is no substantial progress in the trial.
5. The criminal application is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
