1. By preferring this appeal, the appellant has challenged the judgment and order of sentence passed by the learned Special Court in Special Case No.3/1997 by which the appellant is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 7 and 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act.
