2. It is demonstrated from the record that the tribe claim of the petitioner for issuance of validity is pending with the Committee since 13.06.2023 i.e. almost more than a year.
3. Notification dated 13.08.2012 mandates that the Committee must decide the tribe/caste claim within a period of three months and in exceptional circumstances, additional two months period can be granted to the Committee.
4. In the case at hand, already period of more than a year is over.
5. In this view of the matter, we direct the petitioner to appear before the Committee on **25th July, 2024**. The Committee is directed to decide the tribe claim of the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.
6. With these directions, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
