This is an application for condonation of 215 days delay in filing the appeal against the judgment and order dated 27.12.2023 passed by the learned Extra Joint District Judge-4 and Additional Sessions Judge, Special Court (POCSO), Nagpur in Special Case (POCSO) No.598/2020, whereby the learned Judge on conviction of the accused for the offence punishable under Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (for short 'POCSO Act') has sentenced the accused to suffer rigorous imprisonment for twenty years and to pay a fine of

Rs.10,000/-, in default to suffer rigorous imprisonment for six months. The reasons for delay have been stated in the application.

5. In view of the facts stated in the application, the application is allowed. The delay of 215 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

6. The application stands disposed of.
