CIVIL APPLICATION (S) NO.1325/2022:

1. Heard.
2. This is an application for condonation of delay of 648 days for bringing legal representatives on record and 565 days for setting aside abatement for filing application for bringing the legal heirs on record.
3. The learned Advocate for the respondent is not present.
4. The learned Advocate for the appellant submitted that though respondent died it was not communicated to this Court and therefore, the appellant could not get knowledge of death of respondent. He died during the period of Covid-19 pandemic.
5. Considering all these reasons, the application deserves to be allowed in the interest of justice, subject to payment of costs of Rs.1000/- to be deposited with the

Vidarbha Lady Lawyers Association, Nagpur within a week.

6. The application is disposed of.

1. Heard.
2. This is an application for bringing legal heirs of respondent on record.
3. For the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed.
4. The legal heir of respondent be brought on record within a week.
5. Issue notice to the legal heirs of respondent, returnable on 09.07.2024.

CIVIL APPLICATION (S) NO.48/2024:

1. Heard.
2. This is an application for cancellation of abatement.
3. For the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed.
4. The second appeal be restored at its original place.
