amount deposited by the appellant with this Court pursuant to order granting stay to execution of the impugned award. In other matters permission to withdraw 75% of the total amount has been granted. In that view of the matter, in the present case also the respondent nos.1 and 2 are permitted to withdraw the amount deposited by the appellant along with accrued interest on furnishing usual undertaking. In connected matters 50% amount is permitted to be withdrawn on undertaking and 25% amount is permitted to be withdrawn on furnishing solvent surety. However, in view of statement made by Mr. Deshpande that the land in the entire village has been acquired, and therefore, it is not possible to arrange for solvent surety, permission is granted to withdraw amount on furnishing usual undertaking. The appellant had deposited meagre amount of Rs.4,83,053/- which is also a consideration
