The Petitioner has challenged Show Cause Notice issued to the Petitioner on 21 August 2024 as regards the illegal excavation of sand and confiscation of the vehicle.

2. We are not inclined to interfere in the Petition at the stage of Show Cause Notice. Petitioner can urge all such contentions

available in law and fact before the concerned Authority. Considering the grievance made by the Petitioner that the vehicle is lying idle with the concerned Authority, the same is to be considered by the Authority at an early date.
