2. The learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is giving up challenge to the order of invalidation.

3. The petitioner was appointed against a post which was meant for Vimukta Jati (A) category candidate.

4. It is the case of the petitioner that since his services are terminated his candidature could have been considered on a supernumerary post in view of the existing policy of the State Government. In this background, we dispose of the writ petition with following directions.

5. The petitioner to make a representation for absorbing his services on a supernumerary post in view of the policy of the State Government. If such a representation is made within a period of two weeks from today, the decision on it be taken and communicated to the petitioner thereafter within six weeks.
