1. This is an application filed by the applicants/respondent nos.1 to 3 for withdrawal of amount of Rs.5,60,053/- deposited by the appellants.

5. Registry is directed to pay 50% amount to the claimants on execution of usual undertaking and 25% amount on execution of solvent surety. Registry is further directed to pay that amount of compensation to respondent no.1 – Rajesh Gulabrao Kurhekar, as per the power of attorney executed in his favour by other two claimants.
