1. Since we are of the view that the prayer of the intervenors which is sought to be canvassed cannot be considered in the present petitions, the same is not pressed by the learned counsel.

2. Civil applications are disposed of as not pressed. The applicants are at liberty to take recourse to such remedy as is permissible and available in law.

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4. Shri R. S. Parsodkar, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions informs that the petitioner has already superannuated from the employment of respondent Nos.1 to 3.
