1. By this application, the applicant is seeking modification of the condition Nos. (i) and (iii) imposed by this Court while releasing him on bail in Criminal Application No. 112/2024.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant is directed to attend the concerned Police Station on 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of every month, and the investigating officer is directed to record his presence. However, it is difficult for the applicant to attend on 14/12/2024, as there is a marriage of his son scheduled on 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of this month. He is ready to attend the police station on 16<sup>th</sup> at Jabalpur and 21<sup>st</sup> at Nagpur.

3. Learned APP strongly opposed the said application and submitted that at Jabalpur he can attend the said police station, though there is a marriage ceremony in the house.

4. Considering that the applicant has attended the concerned police station and cooperated with the investigating agency, and considering the reason that there is a marriage ceremony in the house, the applicant shall attend the concerned police station on 16<sup>th</sup> at Jabalpur and 21<sup>st</sup> at Nagpur. Subsequent thereto, he shall attend the concerned police station as directed by this Court by order dated 15/10/2024.

5. The criminal application (APPLN) No. 133 of 2024 is **disposed of**.
