The appeal is filed under Section 14A of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

2. After hearing the learned Counsel for the appellant to some extent and considering the fact that now the case is already fixed for the evidence and on merits also, I have shown my disinclination to grant bail to the present appellant.

3. The earlier application is also rejected and there is no change in the circumstances.
