This application is filed under Order 5 Rule 20 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, for substituted service upon **respondent nos. 4 and 7** by paper publication. It is stated that the notices issued to the aforesaid respondents returned back unserved for want of correct address. It is stated that no other address except the present one is available with the applicant. It is stated that the applicant tried to search the correct address of the aforesaid respondents, however, the same could not be traced out.
