1. The learned counsel for the respondent No.1 seeks two weeks' time to file reply.
2. Stand over to **24.04.2024**.
3. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner points out that the bank account of the petitioner has been frozen by the respondent No.2/Bank and the petitioner, therefore, is facing difficulties in releasing salary of its employees.
4. In the circumstances, the respondent No.2/Bank is directed to allow the petitioner to operate the bank account, by keeping 50 % of the decretal amount to the account.
5. The petitioner may operate the bank account, however, the petitioner is not permitted to withdraw the amount more than the half amount of Rs.1,59,71,544/-.
