1. Heard.
2. Issue notice for final disposal to the respondents, returnable on **24.04.2024**.
3. The Petitioner is permitted to serve the respondents by private mode, in addition to the regular mode of service and file an affidavit of service by next date, failing which the petitioner shall deposit costs of Rupees Five Hundred with High Court Legal Services Sub-Committee, Nagpur.
4. The Office objections, if any, be removed on or before the returnable date.
5. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner is pressing for interim relief. It is submitted that today, the matter is fixed for judgment and if the judgment is pronounced, this matter would become infructuous.
6. After going through the record, *prima facie* it appears that sufficient opportunity was not given to the petitioner to lead

evidence. In that view of the matter, there shall be stay to the further proceeding of Regular Civil Suit No.36 of 2017, pending before 2<sup>nd</sup> Addl. Small Causes Court, Nagpur, till next date.
