1. Learned Counsel for petitioner points out that the judgment of the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court dated 12/08/2024 in Writ Petition No.4900/2021 (*Smt. Urmilabai wd/o Morati Kale and Ors. Vs. the Registrar General and Additional Commissioner and Special Registrar, Co-operative Society, Pune and Ors.*), observing that the judgment on which the respondent No.2 has relied upon holding that the revision is not maintainable, is *per incuriam*.
