2. The learned Assistant Government Pleader appears for respondent Nos.2 to 5.

The petitioner has been issued a show cause notice dated 23.07.2024, claiming contravention of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 and Rules framed thereunder on the ground, that in terms of the Notification dated 28.06.2017, the petitioner has not filed an affidavit for availing exemption before the jurisdictional tax authorities stating, it is forgoing any actionable claim on account of the the brand of the petitioner not being registered under the Trade Marks Act. It is the

contention, that such affidavit has yet been filed for which our attention is invited to the affidavit dated 19.05.2018 (page No.69). Our attention is also invited to the show cause notice para 6.2 (page No. 113), which admits the submission of the affidavit and documents regarding the forgoing actionable claim and so also para 6.5 (page No. 117), which *prima facie* show that an affidavit forgoing their actionable claims on account of the brand name of the petitioner being unregistered has been received by the authorities. It is contended, that since that is the only reason why the show cause notice has been issued and since show cause notice itself indicates receipt of the affidavit its issuance it itself is infirm.

2. Issue notice for final disposal, returnable on 19.09.2024.

3. Ms. Sangita Mishra, learned counsel waives notice for the respondent No.1 1.

4. Ms. T.H. Khan, learned Assistant Government Pleader waives notice for the respondent Nos. 2 to 5.
