2. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 20.11.2024.

3. Ms. Naik, learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3/State.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, without prejudice to his rights, is willing to deposit 50% of the penalty amount. It is submitted that subject to the said deposit, the vehicle in question be released, as the livelihood of the petitioner is dependent upon the said vehicle.

5. In the facts and circumstances of the case, the respondent No.3-Tahsildar, Nandgaon Khandeshwar, District - Amravati, shall release the vehicle in question, subject to deposit of Rs.1,50,000/- by the petitioner with the office of the said Tahsildar.
