that the petitioner, without prejudice to his rights, is
willing to deposit 50% of the penalty amount. It is
submitted that subject to the said deposit, the vehicle
in question be released, as the livelihood of the
petitioner is dependent upon the said vehicle.

3. The total amount of penalty is
Rs.2,20,600/-. Considering the facts and
circumstances, the respondent No.3 - Tahsildar,
Kalamb, District – Yavatmal, shall release the vehicle

in question, subject to deposit of Rs.1,25,000/- by the petitioner with the office of the Tahsildar, Kalamb, District – Yavatmal.
