2. This is an application for condonation of delay of 1073 days caused in filing application for setting aside abatement and for bringing legal representatives of appellant No.5 on record.

4. Heard learned Advocates of both sides.
5. Learned Advocate for the applicants submits that delay is not deliberately caused.
6. Considering the reasons stated in the application, the application deserves to be allowed in the interest of justice.
