1. This is an application for withdrawal of balance amount deposited by the appellant in this Court as per the judgment of the Authority.

50% amount out of remaining amount along with accrued interest thereon.

8. The Authority i.e. Commissioner Under, Employee's Compensation Act, First Labour Court, Nagpur is directed to pay 50% amount out of remaining amount accordingly.
