3. Reliance is placed on the decision of this Court in case of M/s. Nagpur Cable Operators' Association V/s. Commissioner of Police, Nagpur and another reported in **1995(2) Mh.L.J. 753** to substantiate the said stand.

4. The petitioner is absent. He shall appear and satisfy on 3.9.2024, failing which the matter shall be proceeded further in his absence, in accordance with law.
