The petitioner has filed this petition for directions to respondents to conduct proper investigation in First Information Report vide Crime No. 596/2023 registered with Police Station Ajani, Nagpur for the offence punishable under Sections 120-B, 406, 407, 420, 465, 467, 468 of the Indian Penal Code.
